In 1995 a group of Huron County citizens approached The Community Foundation of Lorain County (CFLC) with a plan for a permanent fund to support local charitable programs. With technical and administrative support from the Community Foundation, these visionaries created The Fund for Huron County. Governing documents specify that all contributions will be held and invested by CFLC until the Huron County Advisory Board believes the Fund can stand alone as a new, separate community foundation located in Huron County. At that time, all assets held for the benefit of Huron County schools and programs will be transferred to the new foundation. Until then, CFLC is dedicated to helping the Advisory Board in every way possible. From administering unique assets and gift plans to establishing member funds like this school endowment, CFLC staff works with the Advisory Board to build the resources of the Fund.

CFLC is proud to be the first community foundation ever to offer endowed funds for area school districts. Since 1982, grants from these school funds have provided numerous opportunities for enriching the education of our children by providing activities such as Artists-in-Residence, unique classroom materials, camping trips, and honors banquets. School Endowment Funds have grown to make up nearly 10% of CFLC's total assets.

Because only a portion of the market value of CFLC's asset pool is disbursed in any given year, the principal of each fund remains intact and permanently invested in order to provide a lasting source for future distributions. Every contribution helps to grow this principal and expand its impact forever.

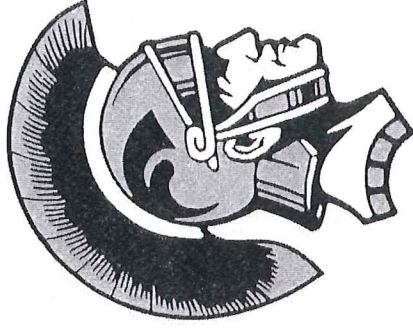

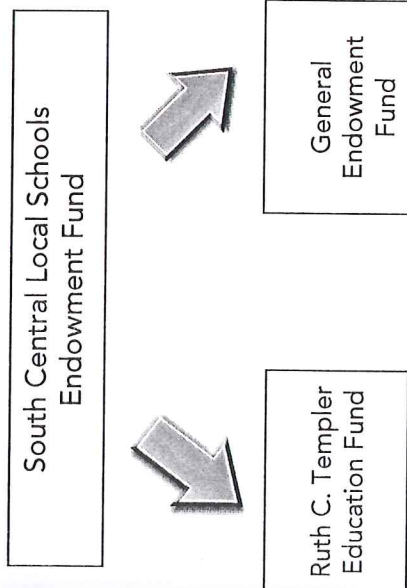

What is the South Central Local Schools Endowment Fund?

The South Central Local Schools Endowment Fund organization was established in 2000 to provide a permanent and stable source of funding to enhance the educational process and programs throughout the South Central Local School District. The Endowment Fund presently consists of two funds—Ruth C. Templer Education Fund and the General Endowment Fund (including student scholarships and grants). The South Central Local Schools Endowment Fund is governed by a Board of Trustees appointed by the South Central Local School District Board of Education.



Money donated to the Endowment Fund is invested with The Community Foundation of Lorain County where it is pooled with nearly 400 charitable funds. Donations are invested, and the investment income earned on each fund is used to make grants.

From the Ruth C. Templer Education Fund, the Board of Trustees distributes one renewable (up to four years) scholarship annually to one graduating senior in pursuit of a degree from an accredited four year college or university. This adheres to the last will and testament of Ruth C. Templer, a lifelong educator in the Greenwich Schools System. In the past 6 years, the Endowment Fund has awarded \$35,000 in scholarships.

A gift to the South Central Local Schools Endowment Fund continues to give for generations. Donations are encouraged throughout the year and are tax-exempt as allowed by law. All donations are deposited with The Community Foundation of Lorain County who oversees and manages the Funds. The following donation methods are all acceptable and greatly appreciated:
